Topic Area	Scenario
Budgeting	It is time to work with staff on your weekly budget. You know you have to pay your rent (\$450) and your phone bill (\$45). You usually budget \$50 for the week to spend on social activities. You also want to buy a tablet which costs anywhere from \$200-\$600. You only have \$650 in the bank right now.
Missed Medication	Every Thursday you go shopping and out to dinner in the local shopping center. You take medication at 9pm and usually go home by 8:50pm so staff can help you with your medications. Tonight you lost track of time and didn't get home until 11:00pm.
Emotional Support	You had a really difficult day at work/program. You are not happy with the way your supervisor/staff spoke to you. You come home and you want to talk to staff but he/she is working with someone else. You only want to work with that staff person (applicant) and you want help now!
Sexuality	You are in the living room alone with your boyfriend/girlfriend. Everyone else is in different parts of the house/apartment. You start to kiss when a staff person walks in.

3. Behavioral Questions

 Before the interview started you and the Supervisor will decide which questions to ask the applicant.

Here are some examples:

Characteristic	Question
Teamwork	"Tell me about a time when you were part of a team working on a project and the team was not working well together. What was your role? What was the outcome? What did you learn from this?"
Flexibility	"Tell me about a time when you were part of a team working on a project and the team was not working well together. What was your role? What was the outcome? What did you learn from this?"
Authority	"Tell me about a situation where you did not agree with your supervisor. How did you handle it? Would you do anything differently?"
Gossip	"Tell me about a time when you heard a rumor at work or school. What did you do? Why did you deal with it this way? Would you do anything differently?"

4. Ending the Interview

- "Do you have any questions?"
- "Thank you for coming in today. You will hear something within the next week."
